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WHAT IS EXPECTED OF YOU...

- 1. Follow your approved degree program.
- 2. Be a <u>FULL-TIME</u> student enrolled in a minimum of 12 hours -Fall and Spring semester. (Summers optional based on program requirements) Scholarship Term August of FALL 2024 to August of SUMMER 2026.
- 3. Email a Tuition Fee Statement each semester.
- 4. Use B & N bookstore system for textbooks/materials.
- 5. Maintain a minimum of a <u>2.0 GPA every semester</u>.
- 6. Attend classes daily (No Withdrawals or Dropping classes) Attendance Sheet



AGREEMENTS FROM STUDENT

- Any class retakes due to failure, will be paid for by the student.
- Submit <u>up-to-date transcript</u> at the end of each semester for GPA check.
- All items purchased at \$400 and above, will be returned to the Foundation if student leaves program of study voluntarily or due to failure before degree completion.
- Upon completion student will be asked to attend an **Exit interview with the** Foundation.
- Update the Foundation on career placement including name of employer, position, and salary as soon as possible.
- Continue communication with the Marvy Finger Family Foundation after completing degree program to provide an update on the status of career.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN... DROPPED A CLASS

- When a student drops a class, it disappears from their schedule. After the "drop/add" period, a student may still have the option to withdraw. Withdrawal usually means the course remains on the transcript with a "W" as a grade.
- This means that the class will not count toward your GPA, but it also won't have a negative impact on your academic record.

FAFSA EFFECTS OF A WITHDRAWAL (W)

Financial Aid/Scholarships - awarded with the expectation of attending classes for the entire semester/term. *Never attending, dropping, or withdrawing* can have consequences for future eligibility.

- withdraw from a class, your tuition charges will remain the same; however, your financial aid may be reduced or cancelled.
- > Students receiving financial aid who withdraw, never attend or stop attending class(es), will have their financial aid adjusted.
- ➤ If class remains on your record and a notation of "W" is recorded on your transcript in place of a grade. Note that a W is not considered a completed course grade. Therefore, a 'W' cannot be overwritten on your transcript by repeating the course.

FAILURE, EXCESSIVE ABSENCES (FX)

- Registered and paid for classes where the students did not exercise their right to drop the course or was not eligible to drop the course because of TSI or six-drop rule regulations.
- > stopped attending
- ➤ Students who are reported by a faculty member with a grade of "FX" (stopped attending) but do not have a reported last date of attendance will be calculated using the 50% point of the semester. The college will retain full tuition and fees of these students.
